- 10. How can the Seeing Red Cars video be used?

The Seeing Red Cars video is an integral part of this year's ORS curriculum, and each district in Zones 28 and 29 will be provided with a USB flash drive that contains the video.

The flash drive also contains materials that can be used for training and discussion in a setting other than an ORS.

The video and the accompanying materials on the flash drive can be made available to clubs for their use through your district.
