Please call on 1 or 2 Rotarians or Rotaractors to briefly (1 or 2 minutes) tell their stories~why they have invited a friend or coworker to attend a Rotary meeting or why they are in Rotary or Rotaract. If possible, contact these speakers before the ORS and ask them to be prepared to "tell their stories." Another option is to have someone share a membership drive/promotion that was successful for their Club. Please contact them before the ORS so they are prepared to share their story in two or three minutes.
